

# SAINT OF THE WEEK

# JULY 29 IS THE FEAST OF SAINT MARTHA

Martha was the sister of Mary and Lazarus. The Bible tells us that Jesus stayed with Martha and her family on at least three occasions. Martha served Jesus and showed him great hospitality while he visited her home. During one visit, Martha's sister Mary sat listening to Jesus while Martha did all of the work! Martha asked Jesus to intervene and tell Mary to help her. Jesus responds that Martha is worried about many things that distract her from being truly present to him. Jesus reminds Martha that the one thing that is truly important is to listen to him.

Sometimes we behave like Martha – worried and distracted by all we have to do, and we forget to spend time with Jesus. Here's a short prayer that may help: "Saint Martha, pray for us that we might serve Jesus better. Help us to overcome our distractions and worries so that we may listen to his words and be present to him this day. Amen."

# Dear Padre,

# Should we send our child to a Catholic school? Luckily, we can afford it. But what are the advantages?

In a Catholic school your child will be exposed to faith development and to religious, moral, and disciplinary values that some public schools can't impart. This is in addition to a high-quality general education. A 2019 study by the National Center for Education Statistics shows that the all-important math and reading assessments for Catholic school fourth- and eighth-graders surpassed those of their public school cohorts.

A well-run Catholic school can offer your child an educational experience and life formation based on the message, values, and principles of Jesus Christ. These are the preeminent reasons to choose a Catholic school. You want your child to hear the story of Jesus, to know and admire him, to grow up as one of his devoted friends and disciples.

Children need to see the message of Jesus lived out enthusiastically by their parents, teachers, and the adult faith community, of which the school is a part. Catholic schools will teach a value system clearly rooted in Jesus' gospel message. The children will discover that God's creation is good, to be respected and cared for. The children will sense and appreciate their own intrinsic worth as human beings and the dignity of everyone. They will develop sensitivity to the poor and less fortunate. In short, children need the faith formation that a Catholic school offers.
