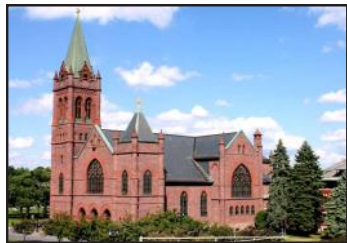

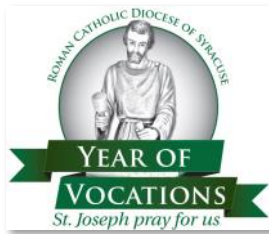
We give all of these items to the local school nurses, cancer & infusion centers, local adult facilities, and to individuals upon request.
