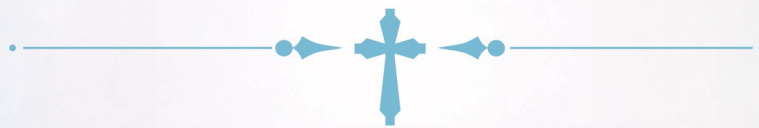

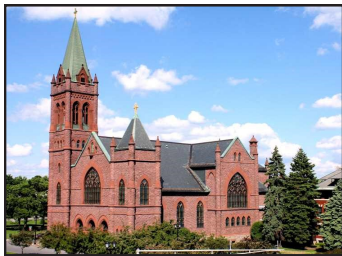

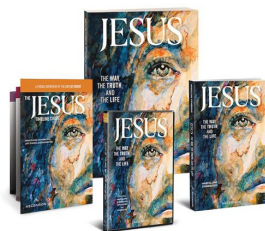
TREE OF LIGHTS
