



#### **SEPARATED & DIVORCED SUPPORT GROUP**

### **GRIEF SURVIVORS**

The Grief Survivors support group allows individuals to explore their feelings, find support from individuals experiencing similar feelings, and move through the grieving process. Individuals are invited to share during the discussions, but there is no pressure to do so. *The program is offered every other Tuesday from 6:00 to 7:30 PM*.
