EULOGIES AT FUNERALS

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Before I address the questions about family members delivering a eulogy during the Funeral Mass, let me start by wishing all of you a Happy and Healthy New Year as we begin 2022.

Since January 2020, here at St. Peter's Parish, eulogies have been discouraged during the Funeral Mass. This has been met with a mix of responses. Everything from families being angry, to families feeling relieved from the pressure that comes from public speaking at such a difficult time. The main question raised by some families is: "Why not?" Some think it is my personal decision or preference. Let me explain why and hopefully bring clarity and understanding with regards to eulogies not being delivered within the Funeral Mass.

Since 2012, it has been the policy of the Diocese of Syracuse to encourage a eulogy at the Vigil Service (wake/calling hours), after the Committal Service (cemetery service) or at the reception that normally follows the Fraternal Rites of Christian Burial. You can find this policy on the Diocesan website. The policy states, in part, "This liturgy (the Funeral Mass), offers comfort and consolation to those who mourn. The Mass lifts our hearts to God who will strengthen us in the days ahead and give us the grace of His comfort as we continue our journey of faith. Since the Funeral Mass leads us to reflect on Eternal Life, eulogies are discouraged....current liturgical guidelines strongly discourage this." Also, section 382 of the Revised Roman Missal states; "At the Funeral Masses, there should be a short homily, but to the exclusion of a funeral eulogy of any kind."

It is not that I won't allow a eulogy, based on my personal preference as a Pastor, but rather it is my obligation as a Pastor to follow the policy of the Diocese of Syracuse. I know that the loss of a loved one is very difficult. It is an experience we all share at different times in our lives. Eulogies can be, by sharing memories and stories, a great source of Consolation. At the Vigil Service, after the Committal Service, or at the reception are wonderful opportunities to share these memories and support each other in love.

I hope this clears up confusion, answers questions and brings understanding to this topic which gets raised on occasion. Please keep me in your prayers that I may be a good pastor, and know that you are in my prayers.

On January 22 each year, the Catholic Church in the United States observes a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of the Unborn Children to mark the Supreme Court decision, Roe v Wade, on January 22, 1973, that legalized abortion throughout the United States.

In 2018, Mississippi passed a law protecting unborn children after fifteen weeks of gestation. This law was challenged and the case, known as Dobbs v Jackson's Women's Health Organization, is awaiting a decision by the Supreme Court. Oral arguments were heard on December 1, 2021 and a decision is expected in June 2022.
