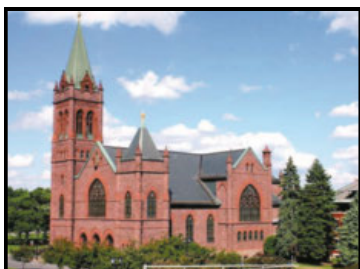

FORMATION IN A MINUTE...

*Laetare Sunday –
The Fourth Sunday of Lent*

Laetare means "Rejoice" in Latin. The 40 days of Lent are a time for solemnity, so how is it possible to celebrate during a time for fasting and sacrifice? Quite simply, the church recognized that people need a break from sorrow.

On Laetare Sunday, the purple vestments and altar cloths of Lent are set aside, and rose ones are used instead. Flowers, which are normally forbidden during Lent, may be placed on the altar.

The fourth Sunday is considered a day of relaxation from the normal rigors of Lent. It is a day of hope with Easter within sight.

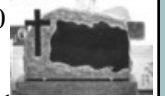

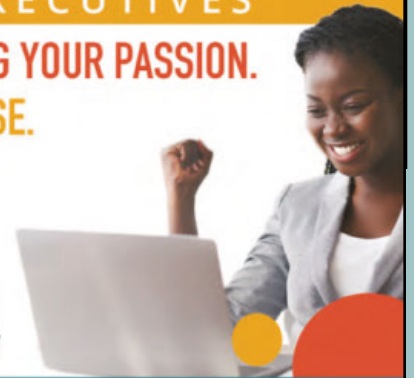
