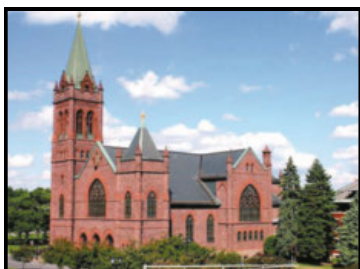

FORMATION IN A MINUTE...

Passiontide

The last two weeks of Lent have traditionally been referred to as Passiontide. The time was set aside for a greater focus on Christ's Passion and death. The first week is called "week of the palms," because it precedes Palm Sunday. Holy Week is the second and final week of Passiontide. During Passiontide, it is optional for statues, holy images, and crucifixes to be covered with purple cloth. The stark difference in the church produced by the covering of images is meant to help us focus on the sorrow and death that Jesus endured. Crosses remain covered until after services on Good Friday and statues and images remain covered until the Easter Vigil.
