FORMATION IN A MINUTE...

The Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Celebrated on May 31, the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary commemorates the Virgin Mary's visit to her cousin, Elizabeth. The meeting of these two women was a joyful and unique event. Both found themselves pregnant in unusual circumstances — Elizabeth in her old age after suffering from infertility, and Mary by the Holy Spirit.

At their meeting, John the Baptist leaped in the womb of Elizabeth, and Elizabeth blessed Mary and the Christ Child. Elizabeth's words to Mary, "Most blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb" we recognize as part of the prayer, The Hail Mary. Mary, in turn, responds with the famous Magnificat praising the Lord. The Magnificat begins: "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; my spirit rejoices in God, my savior." The entire prayer can be found in the Gospel of Luke, chapter 1, verses 46-55.

In our parish church, the Visitation is depicted in the first two sections of our south-facing windows. The windows show Elizabeth joyfully greeting Mary and the Christ Child in her womb. Pope Benedict XVI tells us that this feast day is a day to recognize Mary's humility and willingness to be used by God, and that we should strive to imitate it in our own lives.
