

# FORMATION IN A MINUTE...

# Most Holy Trinity Sunday

Trinity Sunday is celebrated on the first Sunday after Pentecost, and celebrates "the one and equal glory" of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

On Trinity Sunday, the Christian Church ponders with joy and thanksgiving what the Father, Son and Holy Spirit have done to accomplish the salvation of humanity. We contemplate how Christians should respond to the love God has shown for us, praising him and giving him glory. We remember the Father as our Creator, the Son as our Savior, and the Holy Spirit as our Comforter.

The second letter of Paul to the Corinthians appeals to believers to aim for perfection and live in peace, ending with the prayer that the grace of Christ Jesus, the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all (2 Cor 13:11-13).

Trinity Sunday helps to explain the clues written in Scripture that guide us to a fuller understanding of our triune God. The Father is God from the beginning (John 1:1). Jesus revealed Himself as equal to the Father in John 10:30, "I and the Father are one." Together, they sent the Holy Spirit. The Bible tells us, "For there are three that bear record in Heaven, the Father, the Word and the Holy Spirit, and these three are one" (1 John 5:7-11). To understand the Trinity is to understand God more fully.
