### FORMATION IN A MINUTE...



Prior to being ordained a deacon, a seminarian who is studying to be a priest undergoes what is called the **Rite of Admission to Candidacy for Holy Orders.**

This may take place when the seminarian first enters formation, or may take place later on – after a sufficient amount of time has gone by for the seminarian (and the diocese) to prayerfully discern God's call.

During the Rite of Candidacy, the bishop asks the candidates two questions:

- 1) In response to the Lord's call are you resolved to complete your preparation so that in due time you will be ready to be ordained for the ministry of the Church?
- 2) Are you resolved to prepare yourselves in mind and spirit to give faithful service to Christ the Lord and his body, the Church?

To which the candidates respond "I am". After the declarations are made by the seminarians, the bishop says "The Church receives your declarations with joy." Officially accepting the seminarians are candidates for the priesthood.
