FORMATION IN A MINUTE...

Our Lady of Sorrows

The Catholic Church celebrates the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows on September 15, the day after the feast of the Holy Cross to show the close connection between Jesus' Passion and Mary's Sorrows. This advocacy has its roots in the Gospel.

The Seven Sorrows of Mary are a popular religious theme and a Roman Catholic devotion. In Christian imagery, the Virgin Mary is portrayed sorrowful and in tears, with one or seven swords piercing her heart, iconography based on the prophecy of Simeon in Luke 2:34-35

The Seven Sorrows (or *Dolors*) are events in the life of Mary that are a popular devotion and are frequently depicted in art. These Seven Sorrows should not be confused with the five Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary.

Traditionally, the Seven Sorrows are:

The Prophecy of Simeon as found in Luke 2;

The Flight into Egypt from Matthew 2;

The Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple of Jerusalem, also in Luke 2;

Mary's meeting Jesus on the Via Dolorosa, the Fourth station of the Cross;

The Crucifixion of Jesus on Mount Calvary

Jesus is Taken Down from the Cross.

The Burial of Jesus by Joseph of Arimathea!

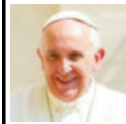

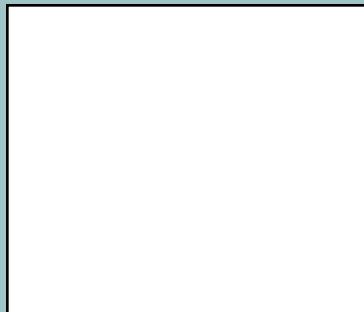

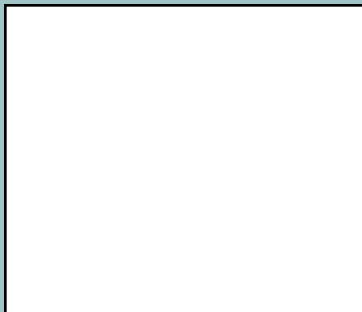
