Catechetical Sunday

September 18th is Catechetical Sunday, a day when the church recognizes and celebrates all who devote their time and talents to the faith formation of our youth.

A PRAYER FOR UKRAINE

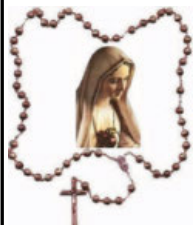
