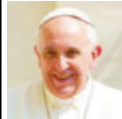
National Vocation Awareness Month

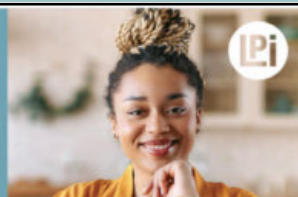
