

Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. (Mt 5:3)

Blessed are those who are convinced of their basic dependency on God, whose lives are emptied of all that doesn't matter, those for whom the riches of this world just aren't that important. The kingdom of God is theirs

Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the land. (Mt 5:5) Blessed are those who know that all they are is a gift from God, and so they can be content with their greatness and their smallness, knowing themselves and being true to themselves. For they shall have the earth for their heritage.

Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy. (Mt 5:7) Blessed are the merciful, those who remember how much has been forgiven them, and are able to extend this forgiveness into the lives of others. For they too shall receive God's mercy.


