Safe Environment Training

The Diocese of Syracuse requires Safe Environment Training for all clergy, members of a religious order, parish and diocesan employees and adult volunteers whose ministry or role places them in regular contact with children, young people, or vulnerable adults about the prevention of sexual abuse. The required Safe Environment training also teaches attendees how to recognize predatory behaviors, and review proper boundaries, and maintain a culture of awareness, knowledge, and vigilance for those entrusted in our care.

The initial training, <u>Protecting God's Children</u>, is a two-hour session for new employees and new volunteers. Recertification training, <u>Entrusted to Protect</u>, <u>Dedicated to Restore</u>, is a one and one half hour session that is required every five years after the initial training is completed. Both training sessions require the completion of a criminal background check.

There are currently two sessions of Safe Environment Training being offered in our area:

<u>Protecting God's Children</u> (initial training) – Tuesday, June 6 at 10:00AM at St. Joseph's in Lee Center

<u>Entrusted to Protect, Dedicated to Restore</u> (recertification) – Monday, June 5 at 6:00PM at St. Peter's Church.

Types of Deacons in the Catholic Church

There are two types of deacons in the Catholic Church: permanent deacons and transitional deacons.

Here at St. Peter's, our permanent deacon is Deacon Nick Rosher.

Permanent deacons are ordained to the diaconate as a permanent state of life and ministry. They are often married men who are called to serve the Church in this way and who have the opportunity to serve in a variety of ministerial roles, such as preaching, administering the sacraments, and assisting in the liturgy. Permanent deacons may also be involved in works of charity and social justice, as well as serving in pastoral care and catechesis.

Transitional deacons, on the other hand, are men who are preparing for ordination to the priesthood. They are ordained to the diaconate on a temporary basis as a step towards priestly ordination. Transitional deacons also have the opportunity to serve in a variety of ministerial roles, but their primary focus is on preparing for the priesthood and completing the necessary academic and spiritual formation.

Our Seminarian, Ben Schrantz was just ordained a transitional deacon. In a year he will be ordained a priest.

In both cases, deacons are ordained to serve the Church and to assist the bishop and the priests in their ministry. They are an important part of the ordained ministry of the Church and play a vital role in the life of the Church.


