

A FAMILY PERSPECTIVE

September 8, 2024: 23rd Sunday (Mark 7:31-37)

Because the deaf man in today's gospel recognized his disability, he could seek help from Jesus. Before Jesus can enter your home and heal, you must first recognize your deafness.

Differences in opinion are embraced without judgment and we provide an atmosphere of understanding and the freedom to talk.
