





A FAMILY PERSPECTIVE

May 18, 2025: Fifth Sunday of Easter

(JN 13:31-33a, 34-35)

In today's gospel Jesus tells us: "Love one another." Love holds a family together. It is not what a family does which makes it outstanding, rather it is what it has, love for one another.



Pope Leo XIV

born Robert Francis Prevost, the 267th Pope of the Roman Catholic Church following his election on May 8, 2025.



He is the first Augustinian and the second Pope from the Americas, after Pope Francis. He was born in

Chicago, IL and attended Villanova University, PA. Prior to his election, he served as Prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops and President of the Pontifical

Commission for Latin America.

His coat of arms offers a clear reflection of his Augustinian roots and the values he seeks to promote

during his pontificate, particularly unity and communion within the Church. The upper diagonal has a blue background with a white lily. The lower diagonal displays an image that recalls the Order of Saint Augustine: a closed book with a heart pierced

by an arrow. This is a direct reference to the conversion experience of Saint Augustine himself, who described his personal encounter with God's Word using the phrase:"Vulnerasti cor meum verbo tuo" - "You have pierced my heart with your Word."

His chosen motto reflects the Augustinian tradition: "In Illo uno unum", which means "In the One, we are one." The phrase is taken from Saint Augustine's Exposition on Psalm 127, where he explains that "although we Christians are many, in the one Christ we are one."
