



### Where will the Sacred Heart Parish Offices be located?

Sacred Heart offices will be at the St. Paul's location on 1807 Bedford Street. Office hours will be Monday – Thursday 9 AM – 2 PM and Friday 9 AM – noon. The telephone number is: 315-336-3082.

#### What will be the daily mass schedule for Sacred Heart Parish and where will daily mass be offered?

Beginning on Monday, July 7, 2025, daily Mass will be offered Monday – Saturday at the St. Peter's location. The schedule is:

- Monday, Wednesday, and Friday at 7:00 AM
- . Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday at 8:00 AM

#### When and where will Confession be offered?

Confession will be on Fridays from 5:00 – 6:00 PM, at the St. Peter's location. Benediction will follow for those who wish to participate.

#### How about Baptism?

To provide families the ability to choose the location for a child's Baptism, the sacrament will be conducted once a month at each of our four (4) locations. Baptisms will be held after the weekend Mass at that location. The schedule will be:

- 1st weekend of the month at St. John the Baptist/Transfiguration
- 2nd weekend of the month at St. Peter's
- · 3rd weekend of the month at St. Paul's
- 4th weekend of the month at St. Joseph's

# When will we be able to purchase mass cards or mass intentions for masses beginning in July? Who will we contact and where will they be located? Will there be any restrictions?

Starting on Monday, July 7, 2025, anyone wishing to purchase mass cards or request mass intentions should contact Lori Ayers DeSousa at the new Sacred Heart Parish Offices at the St. Paul's location on 1807 Bedford Street, Rome, NY. Office hours will be Monday – Thursday 9 AM – 2 PM and Friday 9 AM – noon. Telephone number is: 315-336-3082.

The Church has issued new guidelines governing Mass intentions and stipends emphasizing both proper spiritual understanding and practical solutions for modern pastoral challenges. According to the updated norms, approved by Pope Francis on Palm Sunday, 2025, bishops' conferences or provincial councils may now permit priests to accept multiple offerings from different donors for a single Mass with a "collective intention" but only when all donors have been explicitly informed and freely consented.

Father Seán will be discussing with Bishop Lucia how the new guidelines will be implemented in the Syracuse Diocese at a meeting later in June.

#### Will the Children's Liturgy be offered at weekend Mass?

Robin Calandra will serve as the lead and coordinator for the weekend Children's Liturgy. The ability to offer this program is dependent upon the availability of volunteers that have completed the Diocesan Safe Environment Certification Training. For the safety and wellbeing of our children NYS Law and Diocesan Policy require that a minimum of two (2) certified volunteers conduct each session. Currently, the number of certified volunteers is limited, therefore, initially the program will be offered on Sunday, at the 8:30 AM Mass at the St. John the Baptist/Transfiguration location and at the 10:30 AM Mass at the St. Peter's location where it is anticipated that the largest number of children and families will be in attendance. The program will expand to vigil masses at St. Paul's and St. Joseph's if additional volunteers become available and the number of children in attendance at these masses warrants it. The Children's Liturgy program runs from September - July each year. August is a vacation month for all the hardworking volunteers.
