



**Pentecost Sunday**

### **June 15<sup>th</sup>**

May expectant fathers lovingly support  
the mothers of their children

*let us pray to the Lord:*

**The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**  
*(Father's Day is not a liturgical feast but is often recognized at Mass.)*

### **June 22<sup>nd</sup>**

May the worthy reception of Jesus in the Eucharist  
strengthen our commitment  
to protect the gift of human life  
from conception to natural death;  
*let us pray to the Lord:*

**The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)**

### **June 29<sup>th</sup>**

For religious liberty:  
That all may have the freedom  
to follow God's commands  
and protect his gift of human life;  
*let us pray to the Lord:*

**The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles**


